Description

Ski tour from the Glieshof to the Malga di Mazia and Cima Pleres

Leaving from the Glieshof you reach the forest trails by crossing the bridge that takes you left of the river down to the valley towards the Malga di Mazia at Fuori. Passing through grassland, you shortly reach a sign post. Here, you follow the sign "Klamm-Oberettshütte-Umweg". A bit further on, there is a green sign marked "Tourenlenkung" affixed to a tree. On the climb toward the woods and along the Karenweg pathway, you reach a large clearing.

From there, keep to the left and continue the climb through the grassland. In an optimal point you cross the stream's basin and shortly after reach Pleresboden (2355 m). Afterwards, you follow in a north - northwest direction through the site of the "Planoalerloch". Cross this basin until reaching the steep slope at the foot on the Valvell mountain ridge. Finally, towards the right, you reach a flat terrain. Having reached the ridge and passed the rocky part to the southwest you reach the highest point with the summit cross (3188 m).

The descent retraces the same path. If the conditions are safe, you also have the chance of continuing along a beautiful long and steep incline towards more flat terrain and, crossing the Pleresboden, you return to the Malga di Mazia. Alternatively, you can also descend from the summit by crossing the rocky crest to the south east for a short stretch and from there, turn right in a southwest direction onto the slope running downhill from the summit.
